World Team Cup

Date: Sunday 28th March 2010, 15.30 – 17.30

Location: Sporthalle im Schulzentrum, Gutenbergstr.1, 57413 Finnentrop

Competition: The World Team Cup 2010 is a team competition to which the four best teams from the last World Championships are invited.

Participating nations:

The following teams will take part in the World Team Cups 2010:

Team 1: Germany → **Team World Champion 2009**

Team 2: The Netherlands → 2nd Place Team World Championships 2009
 Team 3: Japan → 3rd Place Team World Championships 2009
 Team 4: Switzerland → 4th Place Team World Championships 2009

→ Per team 1 coach + 1 delegation leader

COMPETITION FORMAT

Each team will consist of 4 gymnasts (juniors and/or seniors) performing in the following disciplines

- 2 x Straight-line to music
- 2 x Spiral
- 1 x Vault
- 1 elective routine (either straight-line to music OR spiral OR vault)

A gymnast may perform **up to three exercises** – but **maximum** one exercise **per discipline**. The **lowest of all six** individual scores will **be dropped from the team score**.

The International Code of Points of the IRV applies.

- Each team enters its gymnasts in the start list without knowing the order in which the other teams have entered their gymnasts.
- The competition will consist of six rounds. One gymnast per team will compete in each round.
- At the beginning of each round the gymnasts know which other disciplines will be performed, but (apart from for their own team) they do not know who will be competing in these disciplines.
- At the end of each round the gymnasts' scores will decide the order within the round (highest to lowest). The teams will be awarded points on the basis of this order:

Winner of the round: 4 points
Second place in the round: 3 points
Third place in the round: 2 points
Fourth place in the round: 1 point

• At the end of six rounds the sum of these points will give the final team scores.

- Each team has the opportunity to nominate **ONE JOKER** at the beginning of **one** of the six rounds. This joker means that the points obtained by the team for that round will be doubled. A joker has to be nominated **IMMEDIATELY BEFORE** the teams reveal which gymnasts are competing in the round.
- It is possible for all the teams to nominate their joker in the same round or for the jokers to be nominated in different rounds.

Costs

So far, the organiser guarantees free overnight accommodation (maximum 2 nights), meals and transport to the competition venue for all official team members (delegation leaders, gymnasts + judges).

If the organiser receives **enough funding from sponsors**, it is **hoped** to be able to contribute to the travel expenses (plane, train, bus, car) for all the official team members (delegation leaders, 4 gymnasts + judges):

Attention:

The exact level of financial support will be communicated to the participants as soon as possible.

Judges

All four teams must each register **two judges** who do not compete in the World Team Cup nor have any other official function. All judges must already have a basic judging qualification (written confirmation of judging competence) and/or must have judged **in all three disciplines** at an international level. The ITC in co-operation with the IRV Judging Officer will decide which judges to use in the World Team Cup.

All judges are requested to dress according to the following dress code:

- Black trousers/skirt. NOT jeans!
- White shirt/blouse
- Black blazer/jacket (no leather)
- Tie/Scarfes (will be supplied by the IRV)
- Suitable black shoes. NOT trainers! NOT stilettos!
