You will establish a modern coaching and leadership culture based on reflection, appreciation and ethics.

Your responsibilities

- **Programme development:** Sporting and organisational responsibility in the women's section, including annual planning, milestones and quality standards (FTEM-oriented).
- Athlete development: Support and development of athletes in the cantonal squad holistic (performance, health, mental well-being, school/work) appropriate to age and level.
- **Training management & methodology:** Periodisation, technique/methodology development on all equipment; sensible progression and level assurance.
- **Performance diagnostics:** Use of screening, testing and video analysis; derivation of individual development plans in conjunction with physio/medicine/mental training.
- **Prevention & athlete protection:** Systematic load control, return-to-train/comp processes; consistent implementation of ethical guidelines and safe sport.
- **Competition coaching:** Preparation and support for national and selected international competitions; performance reviews and learnings.
- Interface management: Close cooperation with men's artistic gymnastics, parents, clubs, schools/partners, STV/Swiss Olympic and ATV management.
- **Innovation:** Active observation of international trends and developments and transfer into everyday training. Contributing new ideas and implementing innovative approaches and concepts.
